While Director of the Australian Bureau of Agricultural Economics, Dr Stoeckel initiated and directed programs of research, which included studies of European policies and international trade that received world acclaim. He has over thirty publications to his credit, including the co-authored *Macroeconomic Consequences of Farm Support Policies* (1988), *Western Trade Blocs: Game, Set or Match for Asia-Pacific and the World Economy?* (1990) and *One Shoe per person: Explaining the Hidden Trade-Offs in Protection Policy* (1996). Dr Stoeckel has contributed to Cairns Group Farm Leaders meetings in Sydney (1998), Seattle (1999) and Banff (2000).
